<p>Personal data are processed for the following purposes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the performance of the concluded contract for the participation in the activities of the Football Academy, including the participation in training sessions and competitions, enrolment in inter-school games, organization and insurance of football trips (Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR). • issuing invoices, keeping and maintaining accounting records (Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR), • evidence-related purposes, in case there is a legal need to prove facts and to establish, investigate or defend against claims, compliant our legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR), • conducting direct communication with parents, players, teachers and co-operators of the Football Academy and sending information by the Controller via e-mail and/or telephone devices - phone calls, SMS messages (Art. 6.1.a RODO), • taking photographs and recordings of training sessions and competitions as part of the promotion of a Player and of the Football Academy (art. 6.1.a of the GDPR).

<p>We take care to ensure the confidentiality of your personal data and limit the processing of your data by other parties. However, due to the need to provide an appropriate organization, e.g. in the field of IT infrastructure, we may make your personal data available to our subcontractors, i.e. external entities.
